

OFF-LICENCE RENEWAL

Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 - Section 135

To **NELSON HOLDINGS LIMITED**

The **off-licence** in respect of the premises situated at **238 High Street, Motueka** and known as "**Super Liquor Motueka**" is renewed. Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **NELSON HOLDINGS LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

The present conditions of the licence continue to apply. These are as follows:

CONDITIONS

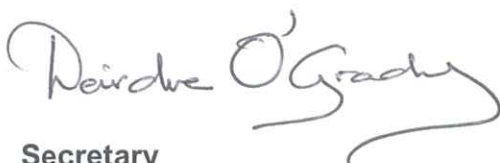
1. **HOURS:** Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - (a) **Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 10.00pm**
 - (b) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day
2. **RESTRICTIONS:**
The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
3. **WATER:** While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, free drinking water must be provided for customers at the tasting location.
4. **LICENSED AREAS:** The whole of the premises is designated Supervised Area.
The defined area is the area outlined on the plan received 4 April 2023.
5. **SIGNAGE:** Signage must be displayed at each point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
6. **OTHER CONDITIONS:**
 - (a) No single sales of cans or bottles of RTDs.
 - (b) With the exception of craft beers, no single sales of any beer less than or equal to 500mL other than those that Super Liquor is contractually obliged to range. These will have a maximum of 7.2% abv.
 - (c) Single bottles or cans from broken packing will be re-bundled for sale into a minimum of packs of 4 units.
 - (d) No more than three (3) A0 price or product advertising signs will be attached to the building.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on
